We take your privacy very seriously and will always treat your personal data with the utmost respect. We also want to ensure that you are properly informed about how your personal data is used by us and what your privacy rights are, which is why we provide this Privacy Policy. Please review it carefully.

About Us:

Denbighshire Triathlon Club aka Ruthin Tristars are a British Triathlon Federation constituted club operating from Ruthin Leisure Centre Mold Road Ruthin Denbighshire LL153EG. The club is bound by policies and procedures as laid out under BTF guidelines to protect members, club officials and coaches and to ensure that the club runs smoothly.

We are the “data controller” of your personal data, which means that we determine the purposes and the means of use of the personal data we collect about you for the purposes of applicable data protection law (which includes the General Data Protection Regulation 2016 or “GDPR”).

What We Collect:

We only collect membership data that is relevant to you including name, address, personal contact details, photography consent and any medical information that is relevant to you taking part in robust physical activity.

The only additional data that is collected is via our delivery partners, British Triathlon and What’s My Time race timing systems (or substitute) whom both provide race information/registration and results for events only. Both delivery partners adhere to data protection laws and the new GDPR regulations (please visit their websites for further information).

How We Use Your Personal Data:

Your personal data is used purely for administrative purposes to ensure that you are kept up to date with club actives or activities that the club feel would be of benefit to its members, such as but not limited to; athletics meets, Cyclo-cross meets, mtb events, road cycling events, gymnastics, swimming etc.

We use the personal data we hold about you to help us respond to any enquiries or complaints you have made or address any dispute which may arise during us providing our club services to you.

Please note that if you contact us through a social media platform, we will only use the publicly available information about you (determined by your social media platform privacy settings) for the purposes of responding to you.

Please see the privacy statements of the social media platforms you use for details of how they use your personal data, who they share it with and how you can manage your privacy settings with them.

We process personal data while maintaining and administering our internal records. This includes processing your personal data to ensure that the information we hold about you is kept up to date and accurate.

Legal Grounds For Using Your Personal Data:

Applicable data protection law requires us to only process your personal data if we satisfy one or more legal grounds. These are set out in law and we rely on several different grounds for the processing we carry out, depending on the purposes of the processing. These are as follows:

Necessary for the purposes of our legitimate club interests

Much of the personal data we collect about you is necessary for the purposes of our legitimate interests as a sports club, which are to:

Ensure effective operational management and internal administration of our club, including in relation to document retention, compliance with regulatory guidance and exercise or defence of legal claims.

Provide our members with services that are as useful and beneficial as possible, including by personalising our contact with members;

In certain limited circumstances, we also process your personal data after obtaining your consent to do so for the purposes of:

Event photography for social media and club website purposes.

Club training photography for social media and club website purposes.

You do not have to provide your consent and can withdraw it at any time.

Who We Disclose Your Personal Data To:

As stated previously we only share your information with our delivery partners British Triathlon Federation and its Home Nations and What's My Time race timing specialists or other preferred race timing companies if our chosen delivery partner is unavailable. The information provided to the race timing companies are limited to name, age, age group, town/City, and county.

How Long Will We Keep Your Personal Data:

We retain your personal data for no longer than is necessary for the purpose(s) for which it was collected. What this means in practice will vary between different types of data. When determining the relevant retention periods, we consider factors including:

Legal obligation(s) under applicable law to retain data for a certain period;

Guidelines issued by relevant data protection authorities.
